Overview

Energy Hub

Energy Hub is a cloud-based software solution for managing your electrical system. It helps you track and analyze data from your electrical system and it can help you increase the safety, reliability, efficiency, and compliance of your facilities. Use Energy Hub to monitor the power reliability of your electrical distribution system and to manage your electrical distribution system assets.

IMPORTANT: The energy and status data shown in Energy Hub is not real-time data. Energy Hub shows the latest logged data for the equipment or monitoring devices. Data updates can take up to 15 minutes.



Web and mobile apps

You can access Energy Hub on a computer with the Energy Hub web app, or on a mobile device with the mobile app. Web and mobile apps share the same system configuration and the same energy data.

App features

The Energy Hub mobile app has two modes: **Site manager** and **Energy Hub**. The Energy Hub user role determines the mode a user is in. Users with a **Site manager** role are in Site manager mode, users with other roles are in Energy Hub mode.

Site manager is focused on energy consumption and the operational status of essential systems such as lighting and refrigeration.

Energy Hub mode is focused on detailed energy system data, such as equipment status, operating conditions, and alarm management.

Site manager mode

Site manager mobile app mode includes the following features:

- Home
 - View information based on energy usage types (Comfort, Lighting, Refrigeration, Other)
 - View energy consumption of individual loads
 - View on/off status for loads, such as lighting
 - View temperature for refrigeration, such as a cold room
 - View alarms and alarm history
 - Receive alarm notifications (email or mobile push)
- Energy
 - View energy consumption for a selected period, such as a day or a month
 - View energy consumption and cost for a location
 - View energy consumption and cost by energy usage type, such as lighting, refrigeration, or plug loads

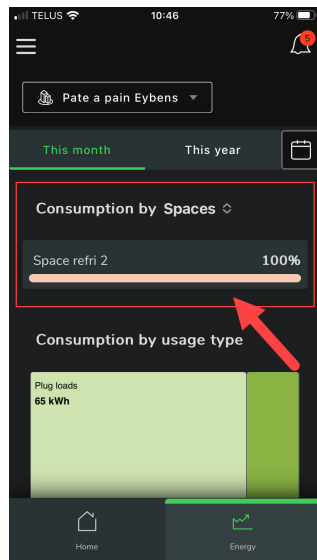


Consumption trends – organization

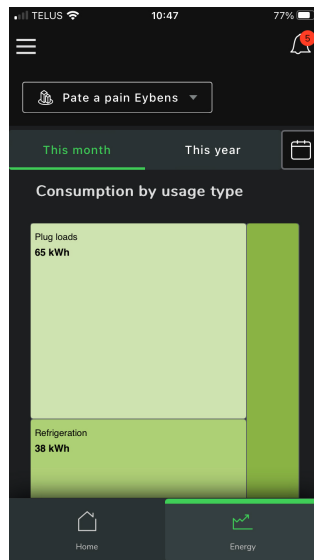
