Note: The following appliances may occasionally cause nuisance tripping of the RCD: Water Heaters, Electric Jugs and Kettles, Steam Irons, Dishwashers, Washing Machines, Swimming Pool Equipment, Auto Defrost Refridgerators and Freezers.

Note: If a faulty appliance is discovered, do not use it in an unprotected outlet under any circumstances. The faulty appliance must be repaired by a qualified person before it is used again.

TEST MONTHLY USING TEST BUTTON

Warning: Residual current devices only protect individuals from Active to Earth contact which is the largest cause of electrocution. It will not protect against electric shock resulting from contact with Active and Neutral wires.


