Product Description

The Clipsal 6200KT Series Extra Low Voltage Key Tag is designed for use in applications where a key card may be needed in order to enable/disable electrical controls. The key tag accepts a standard credit card type key card, which activates a microswitch inside the product. The key tag can be used in standalone applications, where it might be used to drive a contactor. Alternatively it can be used in conjunction with security or automation systems such as Clipsal C-Bus. The LED operation is configurable as required.

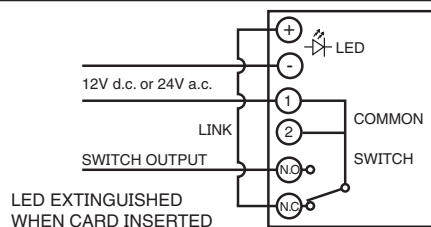
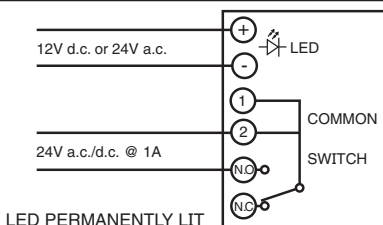

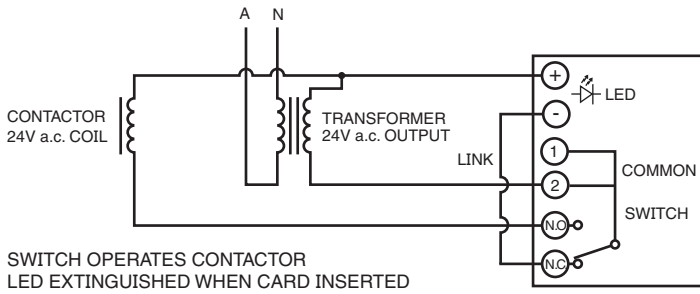
