



# Installation

Replacement Fan 0J-490-0218 for Fan Module AR8213 (Used with NetShelter WX Cabinet)




## Installation

### **Tools Required (Not Provided)**




#### Remove the old fan from the fan module

1. With a Phillips head screwdriver, remove the four (4) Phillips head screws securing the back cover to the fan module.



- 2. Set the back cover **1** aside.
- 3. Pull the wire connectors 2 from their receptacles to disconnect the two wires, one brown (L) and one blue (N).
- 4. Remove the grounding screw **3** with a Phillips head screwdriver to disconnect the ground wire (yellow/green) from the fan.


### Inspection

- 5. With a Phillips head screwdriver, remove four (4) screws from each finger guard on either side of the old fan.
- 6. Remove the old fan.






#### Install the new fan in the module

### NOTICE

It is possible to install the replacement fan so the blades turn in the opposite direction as the blades in the other fan in the module. Make sure the fan blades of both fans are positioned at the same angle.



- Reverse the removal steps to install the replacement fan.
- Torque values for Installation:
  - Back cover screws 1.2 N•m
  - Finger guard screws 1.8 N•m
  - Ground screw 1.8 N•m

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
