# SecureUPS<sup>™</sup> SBP XS30ALLXXR2 Quick Installation Guide


#### **Package Contents**

Inspect the Service Bypass Panel (SBP) upon receipt. Notify the carrier and dealer if there is damage.

The package is recyclable; save it for reuse or dispose of it properly.




#### Wall Mount Options

Install wall mount brackets to the SBP.




#### **Rack-Mount Options**

## **Rack-Mount Installation**




## **UPS Input and Output Cable Connection**

#### SecureUPS and SBP mounting

Use UPS input and output two feet cable to connect the SBP with SecureUPS.

Connect the two feet cable with the seven feet cable, if extension is required. Use this to connect the SBP with the SecureUPS.



- 1. Keep the toggle switch in the **bypass** mode.
- 2. Connect one end of the utility input cable to utility and other end to SBP.
- 3. Connect one end of the output cable to load and other end to SBP.

- 4. Connect the UPS input and output two feet cable to SecureUPS. Ensure that line, neutral and ground cables of the input and output terminals are connected.
- 5. Connect the UPS input and output two feet cable to the SBP (if required use UPS input and output seven feet cable for extension).
