

#### General Information



Description of the product	The XF Coil is an auxiliary device used as Voltage release for emergency off or remote opening applications. The XF release remotely closes the circuit breaker if the spring mechanism is charged, when its supply voltage drops to a value between 85% and 110% of its rated voltage.
Functional unit	The XF release remotely closes the circuit breaker if the spring mechanism is charged, the minimum duration of the pulse operating order must be 200 ms.  It complies with IEC 60947-2 standard.
